

Delegation Trip to Singapore



June 26th - July 3rd 2026. (final week of Term 2).

About the Trip

In 2026, the Waikato Principals Association (WPA) will lead a delegation to Singapore, marking a decade since 42 principals first visited in 2016. This milestone trip comes at a pivotal time, providing an opportunity to revisit Singapore's world-leading education system while exploring the new initiatives that are shaping both their practices and our own evolving New Zealand education sector. The delegation will offer principals a rich professional development experience, fostering international relationships and gaining insights into innovative approaches that can inspire and inform our work at home.

Trip Highlights

The delegation trip will include a variety of activities designed to maximize learning and networking opportunities:

Activity	Description
School Visits	Observe teaching practices and school management in Singaporean schools.
Professional Development Workshops	Participate in workshops led by Singaporean educational experts.
Networking Events	Connect with Singaporean principals, educators and ministry officials to share insights.
Cultural Immersion	Experience the rich culture and vibrant life of Singapore.

Why Singapore?

Participation in the Waikato Principals Association Singapore Delegation 2026 represents an exceptional professional learning opportunity. This visit, marking ten years since the original delegation to Singapore in 2016, will allow principals to experience first-hand one of the world's most highly regarded education systems. Engaging directly with Singaporean educators and seeing their practices in action will provide valuable insights into innovative teaching, leadership, and system-level strategies that are currently influencing global education trends, including those currently shaping our own sector in New Zealand.

The delegation will strengthen international networks, deepen our understanding of future-focused education initiatives, and inspire new thinking to enhance outcomes in our schools. The knowledge and connections gained will have a lasting impact, benefitting not only individual principals but also the communities and learners we serve.
